The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, City of Canterbury) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in the Canterbury district:

Castle Street	Additional parking bays to allow more residents to park.
Flag Iris Avenue	Double yellow lines
Forty Acres Road	Loading bay
Manwood Avenue	Single yellow lines on one side to control congestion
Merchant's Way	Pavement Parking Ban
St Stephen's Hill	Extend Pavement Parking Ban
Sturry Road	Pavement parking ban between Kingsmead Road and New Town Street

Albion Lane	Yellow lines to keep the Curtis Wood Park Road junction clear and to control school associated parking.
Cecil Park	Double yellow lines outside Nos 6 and 8
Gorse Lane	Double yellow lines between Hunters Forstal Road and No 6 Gorse Lane to improve visibility on the bend
Dolphin Street	Loading ban at junctions
Glenbervie Drive	Double yellow lines at the junction with Freshfields
Hampton Pier Avenue	Reduce the time limit in the parking bay from 2 hours to 1 hour to allow for short stay parking
Hillbrow Avenue	Double yellow lines outside Nos 8 - 14, opposite the cul de sac, to protect access for refuse collection vehicles.
Reculver Drive	Double yellow lines near the car park
Reculver Road	Extend pavement parking ban
Reculver Road	Change the times in the parking bays

Church Street	Extended double yellow lines to protect visibility at the give way point and to allow vehicles to pass one another
Chestfield Road	Extend double yellow lines opposite Primrose Way
Cromwell Road	Timed parking bay outside the Co op
Gloucester Road	Double yellow lines at the entrances to the alleys near Castle Road and a pavement parking ban
Herne Bay Road and Marine Crescent	Double yellow lines at the western junction
High Street	Remove 20 minute limit in loading bays near Iceland and Mountain Warehouse
Molehill Road	Extend single yellow lines near the junction with Chestfield Road
The Heath	Pavement Parking Ban
Tower Parade	Time limited parking bay to prevent long term parking
