

The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Canterbury City Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 32 and 35 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, with the consent of Kent County Council under Section 39(3) of the said Act of 1984.

PART A

The Order relates to the following car parks:
